What's New for this edition of **The Inside Tract™ Floor Plans program?**

As housing in Southern California has grown, The Inside Tract™ Floor Plans program has grown too. Not only have we added more tracts to our existing database, we have expanded that database to include more cities as well. In fact, we have added so much new data that it fills up more than one CD.

More Counties Will Be Added

We are also expanding our database outside of Orange County. In order to accommodate all of this new data, version 6 has been designed to provide you with tract and floor plans for other Southern California counties as well. You will be able to order these counties as they become available.

Online Demo

Click this button to find important links on the Internet (you'll need an Internet Service Provider for this). We have also added a new DEMO on the web. You may access it by clicking on the DEMO button on the Menu Bar. We encourage even seasoned users to watch the video. The DEMO will show you how to Email a floor plan, utilize the powerful view tool and much more.

Search by Map

You can now search by map. Just click on "Search" at the top of the screen and then select Search by Map.

Site Button

The Site button has been renamed to Site/Details and moved to the Main Toolbar for easier access.

Site Form

Site forms are no longer incorporated in the collection of Maps. They are now a distinct collection of Site Plans, Features and Details forms.

New Data Fields Added

We have added a new feature to the Tract data and a new feature to the Model data. In the Tract data, we have added a new field for "Golf." Those tracts that adjoin or part of a golf course oriented community will be indicated by a "yes" under the Golf heading in the Tract Features Panel.

What's New? (continued)

You can search for golf oriented tracts by either selecting Search by Golf from the Search Menu or double-click in the Golf text box in the Tract Features Panel. In the Models data, we have changed the feature called "Granny Unit" to "Guest Unit." We have also added a new feature called "Casita." Both are guest units. The difference is that a "Guest Unit" is attached to the main dwelling and has a separate access. A "Casita" is a detached guest unit. Casitas are becoming more common with new tracts in Riverside County.

Revised Find Models Form

We have relocated the Toolbar on the Find Models form from the top of the page down to the center of the page. We found this to be an easier, more intuitive location. We have also added a new Search Neighborhood button providing you with another way to target your search.

We have also relocated the Toolbar on the Find Tracts form from the top of the page down to the center of the page.
